

NOW, Therefore, Know all men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Twenty-Two Hundred Ten

(\$2210.00) Dollars,

to me paid by the said Julian Calhoun

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Julian Calhoun

"All that certain lot or parcel of land in Greenville County State of South Carolina, bounded by lands of Barton Foster and Carruth, beginning on a sourwood and running S. 88 E. 8.25 chains to a sweet gum; thence S.  $86\frac{1}{4}$  E. 22 chains to a chestnut oak; thence N. 1 E. 50.40 chains to a stone; thence S.  $76\frac{1}{4}$  W. 26.75 chains to a dead chestnut; thence N.  $58\frac{1}{2}$  W. 34.40 chains to a red oak; thence S. 12 W. 11.75 chains to a post oak; thence S.  $41\frac{1}{2}$  W. 16.55 chains to a stone; thence S.  $41\frac{3}{4}$  E. 7.50 chains to a stone; thence S.  $64\frac{1}{2}$  E. 61 chains to the beginning corner, containing 292 acres, more or less."

It is the purpose of this deed to convey to the Grantee herein all the land situated in the County of Greenville and involved in the above entitled action, the said land having been bid in by the Grantee herein.

Further, it is the purpose of this deed to correct a deed conveying to the Grantee the above described lot or parcel of land as recorded in Vol. 173, Page 95, April 17, 1936, the original deed having inadvertently left out the second call as indicated above.

The land involved in the above entitled action was sold in two separate parcels and each separate parcel was bid in by the Grantee herein.
