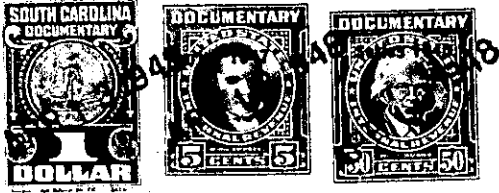

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said. Albart Turner and Louree Turner .....

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, containing One and Forty-Two One Hundreths  
acres (1.42) more or less, and having the following boundaries,  
to-wit:

BEGINNING at corner iron pin on Moody Road, running due  
North 200 feet to stake, thence West 327 feet to a stake,  
thence South 174 feet to iron pin on Moody Road, thence  
East 337 feet to the beginning corner.

This being a portion of the property conveyed to Mrs.
