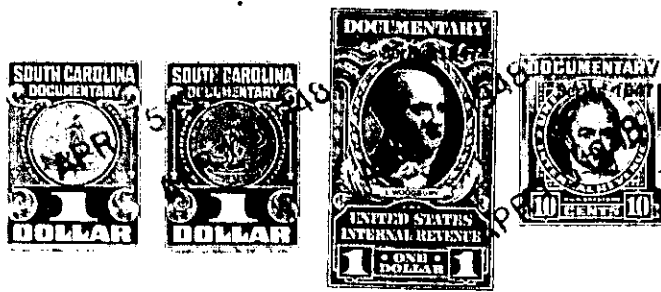

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said F. B. Aiken and Maggie H. Aiken, their heirs and assigns,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, on the western side of Beatrice Street, being known and designated as Lot Number Fifty Nine (No. 59) on Map One (1) of Camilla Park, same recorded in Plat Book "G" at page 225 in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, and, according to said Map, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Beatrice Street at the corner of Lot No. 58, and running thence along the western side of Beatrice Street, S. 17-50 E. 68 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 60; thence along line of Lot No. 60, S. 67-56 W. 195.2 feet to an iron pin on a 20-foot alley; thence along line of said alley, N. 18-32 W. 67.95 feet to iron pin, rear corner of Lot No. 58; thence along the line of Lot No. 58, N. 67-58 E. 196.1 feet to the beginning corner.
