CHARTER  
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, T.L. MACK and PAULINE B. PRUITTE,  
both of 501 New Buncombe Road, Greenville, S.C.,

did on the 13th day of April, 1948, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration,  
signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is UNITED AUTO FINANCE CORPORATION

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S.C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is general financing of the sale and purchase of automobiles and other chattels, and to buy, sell, trade in, and discount notes, mortgages and other evidences of indebtedness, loan money upon notes and mortgages and other securities, and to do any other financing or loan business business which is in accordance with the law of the State of South Carolina, as the directors may authorize,

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00) - - Dollars.  
payable in cash or its equivalent.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is one thousand (1,000)  
of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) - - - - - Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 20th day of  
March, 1948, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: Charles V. Pruitte, Pauline B. Pruitte and C.C. Hindman, Jr.

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, Pauline B. Pruitte  
as Vice-President C.C. Hindman, Jr. ; as Secretary, Charles V. Pruitte  
as Treasurer, Charles V. Pruitte

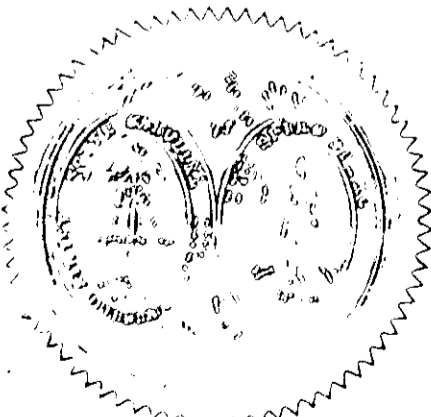
NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1932, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville Piedmont

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, W. P. BLACKWELL, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the afore-said Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
