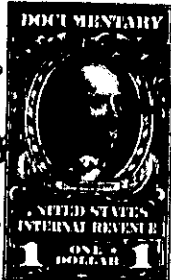


# State of South Carolina, Greenville County



Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Jimmy Antonopolous

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George E. Cheros, and his heirs and assigns,

An undivided one-sixth interest in and to  
All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, on the Eastern side of Augusta Street in Ward Six of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as lot No. 5 on plat of W. A. Bates and George Brownlee made by W.D. Neves on January 26, 1913, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin from the corner of lot No. 4, and running thence with Augusta Street, N. 0-45 W. 23.5 feet to an iron pin, corner lot now or formerly owned by W. G. Serrine; thence with line of the Serrine lot, S. 78 E. 70.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 4 W. 3 1/2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 78 E. 9.2 feet to an iron pin on an 8-foot alley; thence with said alley, S. 0-45 E. 19.2 feet to the corner of lot No. 4; thence with the line of lot No. 4, S. 78-15 E. 80 feet to the point of beginning.
