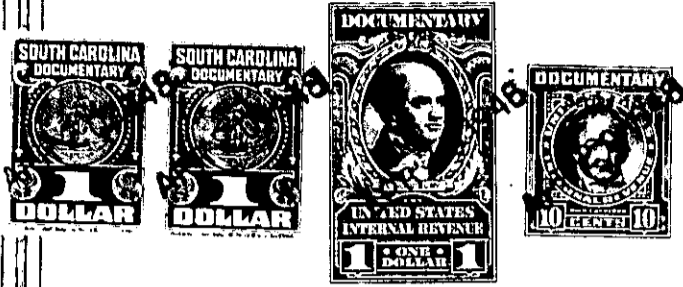

their heirs and assigns forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina Known and designated as Lot #14, Block "C"  
according to Plat of the Chapin Springs Land Company recorded in  
Plat Book "E", page 41, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.

Beginning at a stake on the North side of Pearl Avenue,  
corner of lots Nos. 14 and 15 and running thence with line of said  
lots N. 3-10 W. 125.4 feet to a stake; thence N. 81-28 W. 51 feet  
to corner of lots Nos. 13 and 14; thence with line of lot #13  
S. 3-10 E. 141 feet to a stake on Pearl Avenue; thence with Pearl
