Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Larce Gosnell

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of FIFTY & NO/100 - - - - - Dollars

to me paid by J. W. Gosnell

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. W. Gosnell

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing ten (10) acres, more or less and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Hendersonville-Asheville Highway at corner of property now or formerly of Daniel Hice and running thence N. 24-30 W. 3 1/8 chains, more or less, to cucumber tree; thence with line of property of Jack Eligah in a southwesterly direction 27.50 chains to stake; thence S. 45 E. 1 1/4 chains, more or less, to stake on north side of said highway; thence with north side of said highway in a northeasterly direction 26.25 chains, more or less, to the beginning corner. Being the part of the property conveyed to Lucy L. Hindman by E. Inman, Master, by deed dated November 13, 1922, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 94, at page 26.
