County, State of South Carolina, and being on Pendleton Street and having the  
following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Pendleton Street 128 feet from  
the corner of the lot of Janie Murray Harris and the Oak Lawn School  
lot and running thence N. 19.35 E. 148 feet to an Iron Pin; thence  
N. 72.52 W. 72 feet to an Iron Pin; Thence S. 19.35 W. 148 feet to  
Iron pin on Pendleton Street; thence 72 feet with Pendleton Street  
to the beginning corner.
