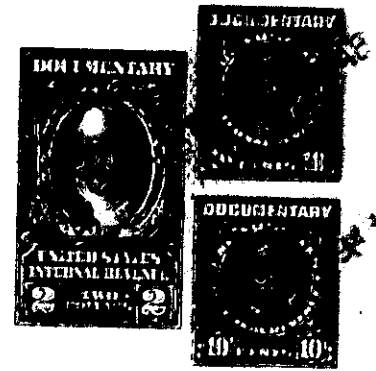
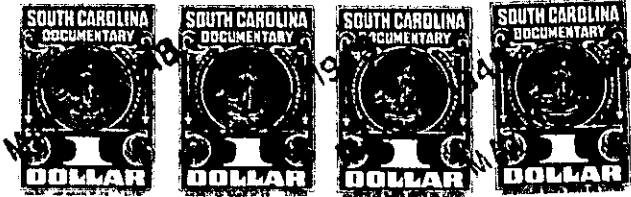

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents

do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George H. Edwards, his heirs and assigns,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, on the Southwestern side of Heather Way near the City of Greenville, being known as Lots Nos. 127, 128, 129 and 130 on plat of Marshall Forest made by Dalton and Neves in October, 1928, recorded in Plat Book H, at pages 133 and 134, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Southwestern side of Heather Way at corner of Lot No. 126 and running thence with the line of said lot S. 33-58 W. 231.5 feet to a stake; thence S. 39-22 E. 106.8 feet to a stake at joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 130 and 131; thence with the line of Lots Nos. 130 and 131 N. 33-58 E. 261.2 feet to a stake on Heather Way; thence with with Southwest side of Heather Way N. 56-02 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner, being the same premises conveyed to the grantor by Van W. Kay by his deed dated April 6, 1946 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 252, Page 425, as well as the same premises conveyed to the grantor by L. O. Patterson, as Trustee by his deed dated April 9, 1946 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 252, Page 448.
