do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Hoyt Turner and Eva H. Turner, and
their Heirs and Assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, about two miles Southwest from Jordan High School,
lying on the West side of the road that leads from the Jordan Road to
and by the George Center place, and lying on both sides of a small
branch, being bounded on the North by lands of Dorothy Henson and Dewey
Henson, on the East by said Road and land of Myrtle Henson and on the
South by other lands of myself, and being a part of the same tract of
land that was conveyed to W.E.Henson by deed from J. A. Henson, et al.,
recorded in the Office of RMC for Greenville County in Deed Book 65 at
Page 146, and being a part of the same tract purchased by me from the
Heirs of W.E. Henson, and having the following courses and distances,
to-wit:

BEGINNING on a stone and iron pin on the East bank of the said road
(old corner called for at the bars of a pasture fence), joint corner
of Myrtle Henson and Dorothy Henson, and runs thence with the line of
Dorothy Henson and Dewey Henson, S. 83.00 W. 741 feet to an iron pin;
thence a new line S. 74.00 E. 364 feet to a pine, 3 x; thence crossing
the small branch S. 67.45 E. 343 feet to a stake in the center of the
said road; thence with the said road N. 12.10 E. 328.7 feet to the
beginning corner, and containing 2.50 acres, more or less.
