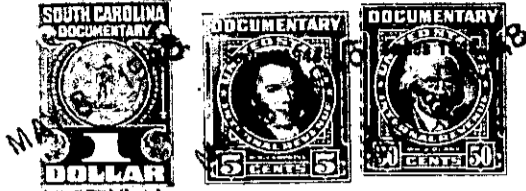

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by ANNIE LINDER & EDNA ROYCE, likewise of Greenville county, South Carolina,
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Annie Linder & Edna Royce, their heirs and assigns forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, on the South side of Conestee Road, and being known
and designated as Lot No. nine (9) on plat of property of E. L. Craigo, made by
W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, March, 1948, and having, according to said plat, the
following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwesterly side
of a County Road, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 8 and 9, and running thence
along the dividing line between said lots N. 56-28 W. two hundred sixty-five
and two-tenths (265.2) feet to a point on the south side of a 10-foot alley;
thence along the south side of said alley S. 54-28 W. one hundred and five
(105) feet to joint corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10; thence along the dividing
line between said lots S. 56-28 E. two hundred eighty-four and five-tenths
(284.5) feet to point on the north side of County Road; thence along the
North side of said County Road N. 45-28 E. one hundred (100) feet to the
beginning point.
