All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about six miles from the City of Greenville, on the Old White Horse Road, containing 65/100 of an acre, being part of the old Thompson land, and having the following metes and bounds according to plat and survey by W, A. Hester, Surveyor, May 3, 1948:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in center of Old White Horse Road, corner J. B. Wynn land, and running thence with said road N. 28 E. 4.70 chains to iron pin; thence with country road S. 22 E. 2.22 chains to bend; thence still with road S. 1 E. 2.32 chains to iron pin; and thence still with country road N. 85-3/4 W. 2.84 chains to beginning corner, together with a right-of-way 15 feet wide extending from the Old White Horse Road to the New White Horse Road over land of James Wynn.
