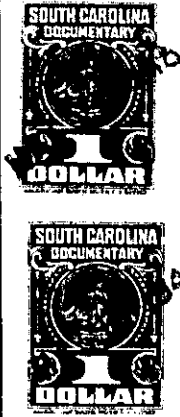

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said..... D. F. Vaughan, his heirs and assigns,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina and being known and designated as a part of

tract No. 24 on a plat of property of E. A. Smythe, et al, made  
by Dalton & Neves, November, 1935, recorded in the RMC office  
for Greenville County in plat book D, page 170, and having the  
following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the west side of National  
Highway No. 29, joint corner of tracts Nos. 23 and 24, and  
running thence N. 88-34 W., 595 feet to an iron pin in eastern  
edge of right of way of C. & G. Division of Southern Railway;  
thence with said right of way, N. 9-35 E., 70 feet to an iron pin  
in line of said right of way; thence S. 88-34 E., 586.9 feet to  
an iron pin on the west side of National Highway No. 29; thence  
with National Highway, S. 1-40 W., 70 feet to the beginning corner.
