FINAL DECREE.

This cause having come on to be heard upon the Bill of Complaint herein, and the report of the Special Master in Chancery, heretofore appointed by an order of this Court, and directed to take the testimony in this cause and to report his conclusions of law and fact thereof; which said report recommends that the relief prayed for in the Bill of Complaint be granted; and it appearing to the Court that this Court has jurisdiction of the parties, that the defendant has been duly served with process by virtue of an order for service by publication, proof of which has been duly made and filed in this Court; and it appearing to the Court that all the costs in this cause have been paid; and the Court being advised in the premises, and in consideration thereof, finds that the defendant has willfully and obstinately deserted and absented herself from the complainant, without any reasonable cause, and has persisted in such desertion for more than two years, and still absents herself from the complainant,

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said report of the Special Master in Chancery be, and the same is hereby, confirmed in all respects.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the marriage between the complainant and the defendant be dissolved, and that the same is hereby dissolved accordingly; and the said parties are, and each of them is, freed from the obligations thereof.
