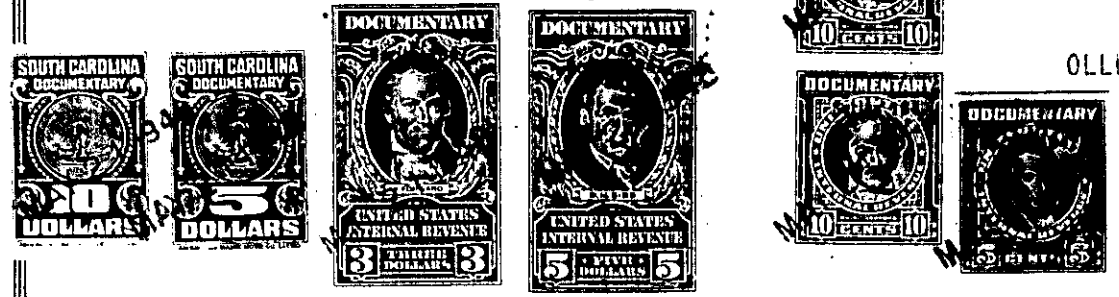

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Joanna R. Vaughan and F. W. Vaughan
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seventy-Two Hundred Fifty
(\$7250.00)- Dollars
to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by Wilma Boroughs Crawford and John Osborne Crawford, Jr.,
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Wilma Boroughs Crawford and John Osborne
Crawford, Jr., their Heirs and Assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the improve-
ments thereon, situate, lying and being on the East side of Laurel
Street (sometimes known as Russell Avenue) in the City of Greenville,
County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot No.
8 on Plat of Property of D. R. Cain, Trustee, made by W. M. Rast,
Engineer, October 1928, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Green-
ville County, S. C., in Plat Book "H", Page 135 and having according
to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Laurel Street, at
joint front corner of Lots 7 and 8, said pin being 53.5 feet North
from the Northeast corner of the intersection of Laurel Street and
East Croft Street and running thence S. 71-34 E. 102 feet to a point
in line of Lot 6; thence N. 19-12 E. 53.5 feet to an iron pin;
thence N. 71-34 W. 102 feet to a point on Laurel Street; thence
along Laurel Street S. 19-12 W. 53.5 feet to the beginning corner.

BEING the same property conveyed to the Grantors herein by
deed of Melville Westervelt, dated September 30, 1947 and recorded
in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book
248, Page 45.

The Grantees are to pay 1948 taxes.
