

thence N. 46-36 W. 22.4 feet, approximately, along northern side of said alley, to point in joint line of Lots Nos. 6 and 7; thence N. 43-21 E. 75.9 feet, approximately, along line of Lot No. 7 to point of beginning on West Washington Street.

No. 8: BEGINNING At a point on south side of West Washington Street, joint corner of Lots Nos. 8 and 9, and running thence along south side of West Washington Street, S. 47-44 E. 20 feet to point on south side of said Street, joint corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 8; thence S. 43-21 W. 75.6 feet along line of Lot No. 7 to point on an 8.8 foot alley; thence N. 46-36 W. 20 feet along northern side of said alley, to point in joint line of Lots Nos. 8 and 9; thence N. 43-21 E. 75.3 feet along line of Lot No. 9, to point of beginning on West Washington Street.

No. 9: BEGINNING At a point on south side of West Washington Street same being eighty (80) feet southeast of Forrest alley intersection, and running thence along south side of West Washington Street, S. 47-44 E. 20 feet to point on South side of said Street, joint corner of Lots Nos. 8 and 9; thence S. 43-21 W. 75.3 feet along line of Lot No. 8 to point on an 8.8 foot alley; thence N. 46-36 W. 18.9 feet along north side of said alley, to point on said alley; thence N. 42-30 E. 75 feet to point of beginning on West Washington Street.

ALSO, All that other piece, parcel or lot of land in said City, Township, County and State, on the southwest side of said West Washington Street, known and designated as Lot Number Seven (No. 7) on Plat made on October, 1920, by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, and being more fully described in deed from John A. Russell to R. N. Tannahill, dated June 14, 1924, and recorded in Deed Book 91 at Page 425, said R. M. C. Office, to which reference is hereby made for a more particular description and same is incorporated herein by reference as fully as if incorporated herein. The said plat is recorded in Plat Book "E", Page 293, said R. M. C. Office. Together with all rights as to said 8.8 foot alley referred to hereinabove.

Being the same property conveyed to Wade H. Greene, Jr., by Leta H. Ingold by deed dated February 19, 1946, recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Deed Book 287, Page 386. The said Wade H. Greene, Jr., conveyed an undivided two-fifths (2/5) interest to Charles Frank Cope by deed dated March 1, 1946, and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Deed Book 288, Page 121. The grantor, Wade H. Greene, Jr., is conveying to the grantee, Alfred F. Burgess, an undivided four-fifteenths (4/15) interest in the property hereinabove described; and the grantor, Charles Frank Cope, is conveying to the grantee an undivided one-fifteenths (1/15) interest
