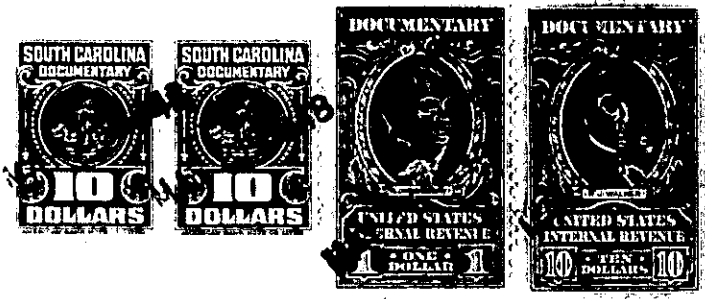

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said the Mauldin Baptist Church

those two certain  
all ~~the~~ piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township,

County, State of South Carolina situate, lying and being on the southwest side of the Greenville-Laurens Road, near the Town of Mauldin, being shown as lots numbers 1 and 2 on plat of property of E. M. Bishop and Stanley Batson, made July, 1945, recorded in the R. M. C. Office, Greenville County, in Plat Book "M", Page 135, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds.

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwest side of the Greenville-Laurens Road at the point where the southwest side of said road intersects with the northwest side of a road leading southwest from said Laurens Road to the Mauldin Baptist Church and running thence with the southwest side of the Greenville-Laurens Road, N. 43-15 W. 175.5 feet to an iron pin at corner of lot number 3; thence S. 46-45 W. 198.9 feet to an iron pin in line of lot number 4; thence with the line of lot number 4; S. 43-30 E. 199.2 feet to an iron pin on the northwest edge of the road leading to the Mauldin Baptist Church; thence with said road N. 40-00 E. 200 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same land conveyed to the grantors by Stanley Batson by his deed dated April 7, 1947, recorded in Deed Book 310, Page 127.
