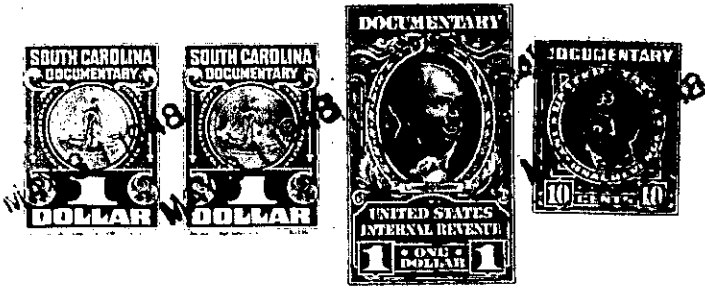

BEGINNING at a point on Marrowbone Creek joint corner of tracts
Nos. 3 and 4 and running thence along the joint line of said tracts N 19-W
490 feet to a point in the center of the new proposed road; thence along
the center of said road S. 71-0 W. 561.3 feet to a point in center of said
road to the property formerly of the E.B.Hendrix Estate; thence along the
Western side of Tract No.4 and the Eastern line of the Hendrix Estate prop-
erty S. 24 E. 348 feet to a point; thence continuing S.21 E. 152 feet to
an iron pin in Marrowbone Creek; thence continuing along Marrowbone Creek
as the line N.57-45 E. 183 feet to a bend; thence S. 82 E. 182 feet to a
bend in said creek; thence N.56-15 E. 188 feet to the point of beginning.
