do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Emmie R. Harris, her heirs and
Assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina About eight miles South of Greenville and
more fully described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on line of land of Betty King. Said pin being the corner of land formally sold by myself to Lollis and running thence along the Lollis line N. 89-11 E. 344 feet to a point in the center of the Old Augusta Road; thence along center of the road S. 0-34 E. 1726 feet to a point in center of said road; thence leaving said road and running N. 89-30 W. 342 feet to a stake; thence N. 36-05 W. 1117 feet crossing the railroad leading to the Army Air Base to a stone; thence N. 85-0 W. 514 feet to a point in the center of the New Augusta Road; thence along center of the New Augusta Road N. 13-49 E. 113.5 feet to a point in said road on Betty King's line; thence with her line N. 74-15 E. 1037 feet recrossing said railroad to a stone; thence N. 17-26 E. 395 feet to the beginning corner and containing 28.54 acres more or less, including area in the roads.
