All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, located at the Northwestern intersection of Brookwood Drive and Reid Street, being known and designated as lots Nos. 25, 26 and 27, Block E, of Stone Estates, a plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C.'s Office for Greenville County in Plat Book G, at Page 292, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Northwestern intersection of Brookwood Drive and Reid Street, and running thence along the Northerly side of Reid Street N. 78- 38 W. 160 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of lots Nos. 25 and 1, Block E; thence along the rear joint line of lots Nos. 1, 2 and 3, Block E, N. 11-22 E. 77 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of lots Nos. 3 and 4, Block E; thence along the joint line of lots Nos. 27 and 28 S. 78-38 E. 160 feet to an iron pin in the line of Brookwood Drive; thence along the Westerly side of Brookwood Drive S. 11-22 W. 77 feet to the point of beginning.

As part of the above consideration the Grantee by accepting this deed assumes and agrees to pay the Mortgage executed by the Grantor to C. Douglas Wilson & Co., dated January 28, 1947, recorded in said office in Mortgages Volume 358, at Page 113, upon which there is a balance due as of June 2, 1948, the sum of \$8,496.28.
