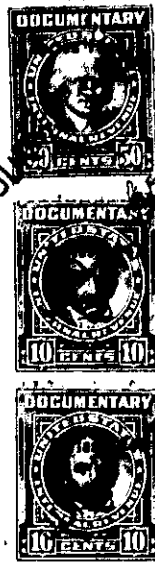
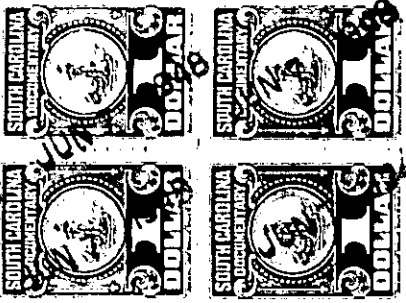

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these pres-
ents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said SEARS, ROEBUCK AND CO., Its
Successors and Assigns, Forever:

All those certain lots of land in the City of Greenville,
County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and
designated as Lots No. 75 and 79, Section H of Stone Land Company
as shown on a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for
Greenville County in Plat Book K, at page 277.

LESS, HOWEVER, that portion of Lot No. 75 heretofore
conveyed to the City of Greenville, S. C. to be used for street
purposes, said deed being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for
Greenville County in Deed Book 152, at page 554.
