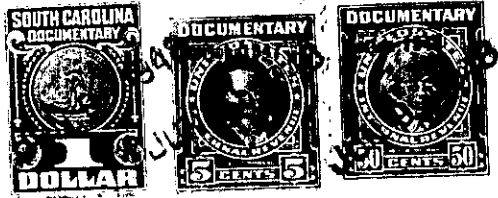

do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Paul W. Cureton and Mildred H. Cureton

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina lying on the east side of a county road leading by
Campbell's Mill and bounded by lands of Grantor, on the south and east and by
Hoe's Creek on the north and Containing Three and 4/10 (3.4) Acres, more or less
with Metes and Bounds as follows:

Beginning at a stake in creek and running thence S. 43-00 W. 700
feet to point in in road; thence S. 63-15 E. 230 feet to a stake, thence along
the west bank of old road N. 45-45 E. 400 feet to a stone; thence N. 28-15 E.
150 feet to a stone; thence N. 9-30 E. 135 feet to a stake on south bank of
creek; thence with creek as property line N. 56-35 W. 129 feet to beginning.
