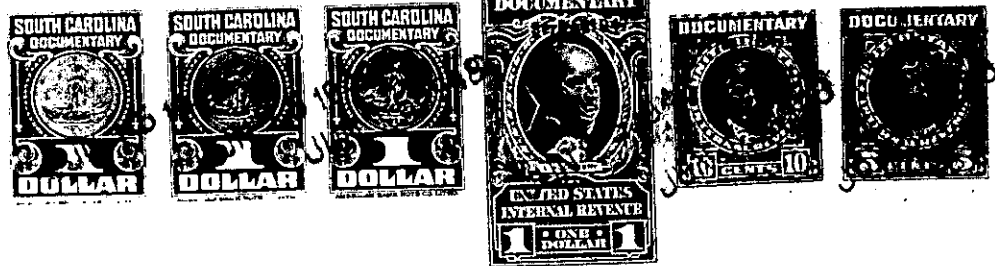

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Paul B. Underwood,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Eleven Hundred and no/100 .....

to ..... me ..... in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by Newton J. Fisher .....  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Newton J. Fisher, and his Heirs  
and Assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, lying North from the City of Greer and the  
new U. S. Highway No. 29 and also lying on the west side of South  
Carolina State Highway No. 14, and being Lot No. 1 on plat of  
property made for Margaret M. Green by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor,  
dated June 2, 1947, recorded in the Office of RMC for Greenville  
County in Plat Book "B", at Page 108, and having the following  
courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the west edge of said State Highway  
No. 14, where same intersects with a new street, and runs thence  
along the North side of the new street S. 84.35 W. 158.5 feet,  
corner of Lot No. 19; thence N. 23.45 W. 50 feet to a stake, corner  
of Lot No. 2; thence with the common line of Lots 1 and 2 in an  
easterly direction 150 feet to a stake on the west side of said  
State Highway; thence with the West edge of said Highway S. 23.45  
E. 100 feet to the beginning.

The above described land is identically the same conveyed to me by  
Margaret M. Green on the 17th day of  
June 1947, deed recorded in office Register of Mesne Conveyance for  
Greenville County, in Book 315 Page 44
