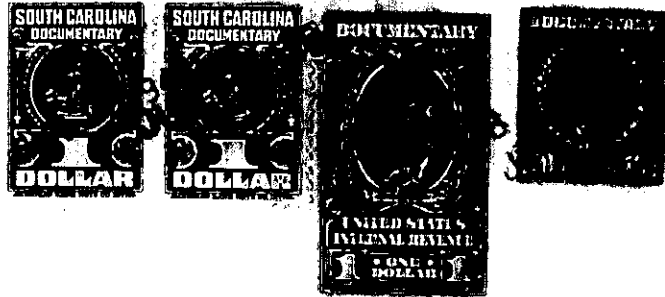

C's Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, at Page 85, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of the Easley Bridge Road, which iron pin is 160 feet in a Southwesterly direction from Harvard Avenue, joint corner of lots Nos. 11 and 12; thence along the joint line of said lots S. 60-51 E. 205 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of said lots; thence along the rear joint line of lots Nos. 12 and 56 S. 27-40 W. 80.7 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of lots Nos. 12 and 13; thence along the joint line of said lots N. 60-51 W. 207.6 feet to an iron pin in the line of the Easley Bridge Road; thence along the Southeastern side of Easley Bridge Road N. 29-09 E. 80 feet to the point of beginning.
