POWER OF ATTORNEY BRIDGEMOUTH

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, W. T. Powers and Marion W. Powers, partners, trading and doing business as W. T. Powers and Company, hereby nominate, constitute and appoint W. B. Long and Joseph Walker, or either of them, our true and lawful attorney for us and in our name:

(1) To sell any and all cotton owned by us and pledged by us, or either one of us, to the South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Greenville, South Carolina, and/or the First National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina, upon such terms and conditions as they, or either of them deem proper.

(2) To liquidate the indebtedness of W. T. Powers and Company and/or W. T. Powers and/or Marion W. Powers to the South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Greenville, South Carolina, and/or the First National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina.

(3) To execute such papers or legal documents, including the renewal of the aforesaid obligations to said banks, as my or our attorneys-in-fact, or either of them, may deem necessary or advisable in connection with the sale of said cotton and the liquidation of said indebtedness.

(4) To endorse and deliver for deposit with or for collection by any bank or trust company or otherwise any and all checks, drafts, promissory notes or other orders for the payment of money.

(5) To make, execute, and deliver receipts, releases, or other discharges for any and all moneys and debts which may be due us or either of us in connection with the sale of said cotton and the liquidation of said indebtedness.

(6) To settle, adjust, compound, or submit to arbitration all claims, demands, suits, accounts, or causes of action whatsoever that are now or may hereafter be pending between us, or either of us, and any person, firm, or corporation in connection with the sale of said cotton and the liquidation of said indebtedness.
