in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto said ETHEL B. WILBANKS, her heirs and assigns:

...ll that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Butler Township, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, located about three (3) miles from Greenville Court House and on the west side of Laurens Road, being designated as tract No. Eight (8) according to a plat of property of Mary V. Harmon made by Dalton & Neves in March, 1944, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book N at page 175; said lot beginning at an iron pin at the joint corners of lots 8 and 9 on said plat and running thence with said Laurens Road South 25 degrees 30 minutes East a distance of one hundred and thirty-two (132) feet to corner of lot 7; thence with lot 7 South 64 degrees 30 minutes West a distance of six hundred and nineteen (619) feet to joint rear corners of lots 7 and 8; thence North 21 degrees 9 minutes west a distance of one hundred and thirty-two and four-tenths (132.4) feet to the joint rear corners of lots 8 and 9; and thence with lot 9 North 64 degrees 30 minutes East a distance of six hundred and nine (609) feet to the point of beginning; said lot being bounded as follows:
