All that certain lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville City and County, and State of South Carolina, on the north side of the right of way of the Greenville and Columbia Railroad, and having the following description:

BEGINNING At an iron pin on the north side of the Greenville and Columbia Railroad (operated by Southern Railway System) at the corner of lot recently sold to J. Roy Pennell, and running thence with said right of way in a westerly direction 200 feet to an iron pin; thence in a northerly direction 200 feet in a line parallel with the line of J. Roy Pennell to an iron pin on Mayberry Street; thence with Mayberry Street in an easterly direction 200 feet to Pennell's corner, and thence with his line in a southerly direction 200 feet to the beginning.

This is lot No. 5 as shown by a plat of Mayberry Land Company, made by Dalton and Neves, March, 1927, recorded in Plat Book H, Page 54.
