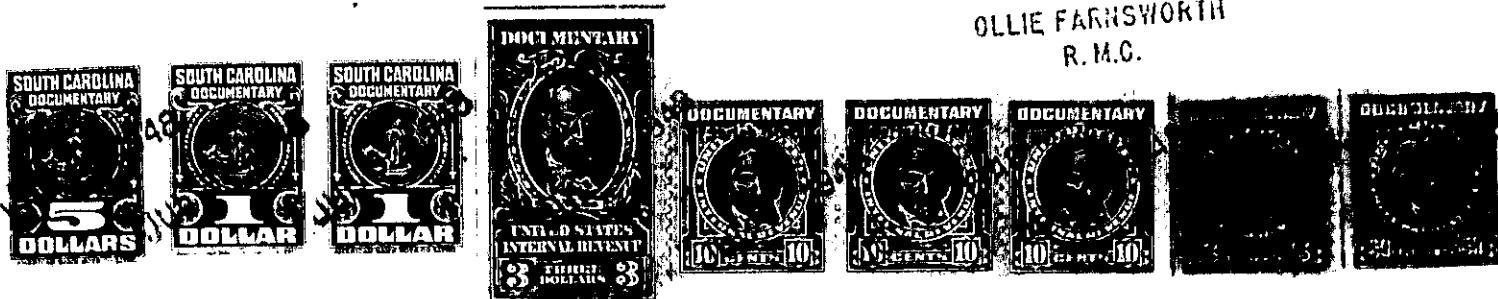

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That ... I, Sue H. Harrison ...  
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand Four Hundred and Fifty  
(3,450.00) Dollars and the assumption of a mortgage in the sum of \$4,800.<sup>00</sup> Dollars  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by J. B. Rasor  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. B. Rasor, his heirs and assigns

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, situate on the East side of E. North Street and East of  
of Richland Creek in the City and County of Greenville; South Carolina and being  
more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on said Street 105 feet South of the Northwest corner of the  
property of Mrs. M. H. Lance and runs at right angles to said North Street back  
to the branch of said Richland Creek; thence down said creek 60 feet; thence in a line  
parallel with the first above stated line to a point on North Street 60 feet from  
the beginning point; thence along said Street in a Northerly direction 60 feet to  
the beginning point.

Said property being the same conveyed to Charles R. Floyd by deed recorded in the  
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in book of deeds 288, at  
page 407.
