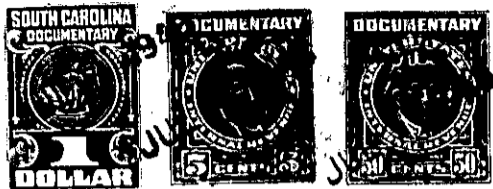

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, O. D. Wood,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Ten and no/100 Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by John F. Stroud

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John F. Stroud, and his Heirs and Assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the South side of the Brushy Creek Road, near the City of Greer and Southwest therefrom, being all of Lot No. 18 on plat of property of the Mrs. E. A. Wood Estate, made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated June 22, 1935, having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the South edge of the Brushy Creek Road, the joint corner of Lots Nos. 21 and 18, and runs thence along the edge of said road N. 76 E. 65 feet to a stake, joint corner of Lots 17 and 18; thence with the common line of Lots 17 and 18 S. 11.07 E. 170 feet to a stake, joint corner of Lots 16, 17, 18 and 19; thence S. 76 W. 70 feet to a stake, joint corner of Lots 18, 19, 20 and 21; thence with the common line of Lots 18 and 21 N. 9.28 W. 170 feet to the beginning corner.
