THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 10th day of October,

1947 by and between Rosa S. Rizk, hereinafter referred to as "Landlord",

WITNESSETH:

That in consideration of the rents reserved and the mutual coverants, promises and agreements hereinafter contained, it is agreed as follows:

(1) That the Landlord does hereby grant, bargain and lease unto the Tenant, and the Tenant does hereby accept from the Landlord the following described property:

The two-story store building located at and designated as No. 21 McKay Street in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being the store building in which the Landlord heretofore operated a store.

- (4) Should any installment of rent be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days after due, the Landlord may at her option, after giving ten (10) days within notice, divine: (4) Declare the fall rental for the entire period due and payable immediately and resort to any logal remadiate at law or in equity for the enforcement or collection of the rent, or to recover damages for the breach of said covenants, or (b) Declare this lease terminated and enter and take possession of the leased
