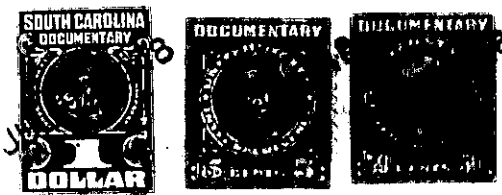

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lloyd E. Hunt, his Heirs and

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, about one mile northwest from Greer, lying on
the eastern side of the Jones Road, being bounded on the north by
lot of Claude Mabry, on the east by lands of Mrs. Gena Caldwell, on
the south by lot of Dan Davenport, and on the west by the said road
and lands of I. W. Jones, and being the same lot that was conveyed
to me by deed from I. W. Jones January 29th 1947 and recorded in the
office of the R. I. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 227 at
page 217, and having the following courses and distances, to wit :-

Beginning on a stake in the center of the said road, joint corner
of the Davenport lot (iron pin on the eastern side of the road at 18
feet), and running thence with the Davenport line S. 81-00 E. 180
feet to an iron pin on the Caldwell line; thence with the Caldwell
line N. 2-44 E. 254 feet to an iron pin on the said line and joint
corner of the Mabry lot; thence with the Mabry lot line S. 79-10 W.
224 feet to a stake in the center of the said road (iron pin on the
eastern bank of the road); thence with the center of the said road
S. 9-20 E. 188 feet to the beginning corner, and containing One (1)
acre, more or less.
