I, J. M. Cannon, of Pickens County, South Carolina, being of sound mind and body, but knowing the uncertainty of life do make, publish and declare this to be my last will and Testament hereby revoking all other wills by me heretofore made.

1. I direct that my executors hereinafter named first pay all my just debts and funeral expenses.

2. I give, devise and bequeath to my executors hereinafter named all of my estate, real and personal, upon the following trusts, to wit;

A. In trust to hold and manage, and invest and keep invested the same, with power to change investments from time to time in their discretion; to collect the income arising therefrom for the use and benefit of and, after deducting expenses of management, to pay over the same to my beloved wife, Annie P. Cannon, for and during her natural life. I hereby give my said executors and trustees power to use so much of the corpus or principal of my estate as in their discretion may be necessary for the comfortable maintenance and support of my said wife.

B. In trust to pay over the principal or corpus of my estate remaining in the hands of my executors, at the death of my said wife, to my six children namely, Myrtle Cannon, Arch B. Cannon, Julius H. Cannon, J. Clyde Cannon, C. Ruth Cannon, and Victor L. Cannon, share and share alike. Should either of my children die before that time leaving a child or children, such child or children shall take the share to which the parent would have been entitled.

I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my four sons, Arch B. Cannon, Julius H. Cannon, J. Clyde Cannon, and Victor L. Cannon executors of this will. I give them full power to convey at public or private sale, upon such terms as they may deem advisable, any or all of my estate, and to do any or all other things necessary or requisite in their discretion to execute this will. They shall not be required to give bond nor to account to any officer or court.
