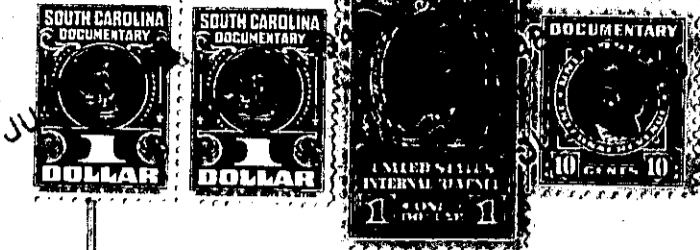

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 7, Section "C" of a subdivision known as Croft Stone Acres. The property herein conveyed is described from a plat prepared by C. B. Dawsey in August, 1946 entitled "Plat of Subdivision of Croft Stone Acres" and has, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Southern side of Wedgewood Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots 6 and 7 and running thence along the Southern side of Wedgewood Avenue, N. 63-10 E. 80 feet to a point at the joint front corner of Lots No. 7 and 8; thence in a Southerly direction along the common line of said lots 224.4 feet to a point; thence in a Northwesterly direction 65 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots No. 6 and 7; thence along the common line of said lots 192.5 feet to the beginning corner.
