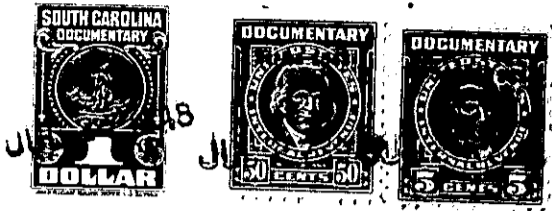

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Belle V. Batson.....

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, just outside the corporate limits of the City of Green-  
ville located in the rear of St. Clair Street and being known as part of Lot No. 7  
of Block A on Plat of the Theron Earle land and having the following metes and  
bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on line of Lots No. 7 and 8, 114½ feet West of St.  
Clair Street and running thence N. 18 E. 68 feet on a parallel line with St. Clair  
Street to iron pin on line of Lot No. 6; thence with line of Lot No. 6 N. 72 W.  
97½ feet to iron pin in line of 30 foot street; thence with said Street S. 64 W. 46  
feet to stake; thence with line of Lot No. 11 S. 26 E. 50 feet to stake; thence with  
line of Lot No. 8 S. 72 E. 97½ feet to the beginning corner.
