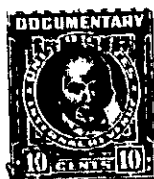

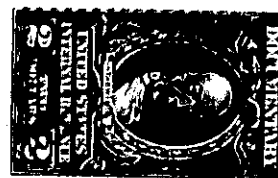

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Duane H. Moss and Elsie K. Moss,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in GREENVILLE Township, GREENVILLE

County, State of South Carolina known and designated as lot No. 135 on plat No. 3 of the property of Overbrook Land Company and Woodville Investment Company, made by R. E. Dalton and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F" at page 218, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Woodville Avenue, at joint front corner of lots 135 and 136, and running thence with the line of lot No. 135 N. 24-27 E. 150 feet to iron pin; thence S. 77-56 E. 40 feet to pin, at corner of lot 134, as shown on said plat; thence S. 12-37 W. 152.5 feet to pin on Woodville Avenue; thence with the northern side of Woodville Avenue N. 73-21 W. 65 feet more or less to the point of beginning. Less, however, a portion dedicated to the extension of Jedwood Drive and the remainder hereby conveyed is described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake at the Northwest corner of Woodville Avenue and Jedwood Drive and running thence with the North side of Woodville Avenue, N. 73-21 W. 65 feet to a stake at corner of lot # 136; thence with line of said lot, N. 24-07 E. 150 feet to a stake; thence S. 77-56 E. 40 feet to a stake on Jedwood Drive; thence with the Western side of Jedwood Drive, S. 14-52 W. 152.5 feet to the beginning corner.
