

4. That in consideration thereof, the said Dorothy N. Elmore does hereby release and forever discharge the said William Marvin Elmore, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, of and from all liabilities, past, present, and future, on account of separate alimony, maintenance, and support; and

5. The said Dorothy N. Elmore does hereby fully, freely, and voluntarily release the said William Marvin Elmore, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns from all past, present, and future claims by right of inheritance or dower in and to all property, real and personal, which the said William Marvin Elmore may now own or may accuire in the future; and the said Dorothy N. Elmore binds herself to assert no claim or demand for inheritance or dower to any property of the said William Marvin Elmore, real, personal, or mixed, now owned by him or hereafter to be acquired by him; and the said Dorothy N. Elmore does hereby fully, freely, and voluntarily release and renounce forever all claims that she may have under the law in and to the real and personal property of the said William Marvin Elmore by reason of having been married as aforesaid, or in anywise incident to or connected with said marital relationship; and

6. The said William Marvin Elmore does hereby release and renounce forever any claim, past, present or future, for inheritance from the said Dorothy N. Elmore or for her companionship and services and does hereby release and renounce forever any and all claims which he may have in and to the real and personal property of the said Dorothy N. Elmore by reason of their marriage as aforesaid, or in anywise incident to or connected with said marital relationship; and

7. It shall be lawful for the said parties to this agreement at all times hereafter to live separate and apart each from the other party as if he and/or she were single and unmarried, free from any control, restraint or interference, direct or indirect, by the other party in all respects as if they and each of them were single and unmarried; and
