- 8. Each of the parties hereto will, upon being requested by the other party, execute or join in the execution of any deed or release of dower or other instrument conveying or releasing any interest which he and/or she may have in the real or personal property now owned or hereafter acquired by the other party.
- 9. It is mutually understood and agreed that Dorothy N. Elmore may establish legal residence in any state recognizing divorce and obtain a divorce in a Court of competent jurisdiction upon any legal grounds which she may have for asking or seeking a divorce from the bonds of matrimony.
- 10. All personal effects of every type and kind belonging to either of the parties hereto shall be and remain and continue the absolute property of such party, free and clear from any claim right or interest of the other party.
- every type and kind now located in, upon or about, and used in connection with, the home on Brushey Creek Street, Greer, S. C., shall be and remain and continue the absolute property of Dorothy N. Elmore, free, clear, and discharged from any claim, right, or interest of William Marvin Elmore.
- 12. This deed, contract, and agreement of separation shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns.
