all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Southeast side of the Old Easley Road, being known and designated as Lot No. 4, according to plat of property of the said Thomas Clifton Collins, made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, August 1945, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Old Easley Road, joint corner of Lot No. 4 and Lot No. 3, heretofore sold by grantor to Truman Rudolph Propes and Bobbie Shaw Propes, and running thence S. 41-10 E. 400 feet to point joint rear corner of said lots and in line of property now or formerly owned by Jess Masters; thence along the line of said property of Jess Masters S. 15-56 W. 76.9 feet to joint rear corner of Lot No. 4 and Lot No. 5, property of T.
