~~XXXX~~ piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township,

County, State of South Carolina on the north side of Horsepen Creek containing
in the aggregate 69.03 acres, more or less and being made up of two con-
veyances but adjoining and constituting a single tract. 39.9 acres of the
land was conveyed to Arthur J. Wood by T. C. Wood by deed dated Nov. 13,
1905, recorded in Deed Book RRR, Page 643. This tract commences in the
center of Horsepen Creek just above a bridge and runs thence N. 29 1/4
W. 20.20 to stone; thence S. 46 1/4 W. 3.39 to a stone; thence N. 50 1/4
W. 8.00 to a stone; thence N. 47 3/4 E. 15.50 to a stone; thence S. 49 1/2
E. 8.17 to a stone; thence S. 34 3/4 E. 21.00 to center of Horsepen Creek
thence up said creek 14.00 to the beginning corner. The other tract which
contains 29.13 acres was conveyed to A. J. Wood by W. G. Abercrombie, ex-
ecutor of the estate of A. Abercrombie, by deed dated April 9, 1923, re-
corded in Deed Book 87, Page 443. It begins at a stone at the corner of
the above described tract of land which is also known as the McKinney
corner and runs thence N. 49-30 E. 13.50 to stake; thence S. 34-40 E.
20.20 to stake on Horsepen Creek; thence up the meanderings of said creek
S. 31 W. 4.45 to bend; thence S. 32-30 W. 3.40 to bend; thence S. 52 W. 20
feet to end; thence S. 43 1/4 W. 2.28 to bend; thence S. 56 1/4 W. 1.00
to corner; thence N. 34-40 W. 21.00 to the beginning corner.

The aforementioned tract of land was owned by A. J. Wood at the time
of his death and under his will all of his property went to his wife,
