SEPARATION AGREEMENT:
R.L.D.

WHEREAS, Arthur B. Hightower and wife, Geneva C. Hightower were married March 23rd, 1946., under the laws of South Carolina and lived together as man and wife for about six months thereafter, and since that time they have been living separate and apart. Now, since Arthur B. Hightower, husband, and Geneva C. Hightower, wife, fully realize that they cannot any longer live together as man and wife, in accord, and in the state of happiness and peace. Now, whereas, the above parties agree to separate and live apart from each other, and each not to interfere with the others acts and doings at any time. The wife, Geneva C. Hightower does hereby release her husband from any support to her and she also releases the husband from any and all rights to interest in any land or real estate owned and possessed by him at any time in the future. This is in lieu of any and all rights of Dower in and to any lands or real estate now owned or to be owned in the future by the said Arthur B. Hightower.

FURTHER, the said Arthur B. Hightower, does hereby release all interests and rights into any property now owned or to be possessed in the future by the wife, Geneva C. Hightower.

It is further agreed that both husband and wife are to leave the personal lives of each other alone, and not to interfere whatever in the movements or acts of the other, and that each will sign proper papers in a Court of competent jurisdiction for any divorce proceedings which either may apply for.
