AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, I, J. F. Blackmon, own a 3/4 inch water line running near the property known as, Oakland Gardens and running near a certain lot designated as Lot No. 27 in Oakland Gardens which has been this day conveyed by me to H. T. Peterson, and

WHEREAS, the said H. T. Peterson is desirous of tapping on said water line for the purpose of furnishing water for his use on said lot.

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. F. Blackmon, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars to me in hand paid by the said H. T. Peterson, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto H. T. Peterson, his heirs and assigns, the right to tap on to the aforementioned water line under the following terms and conditions:

1. The pipe from the meter to any building constructed on Lot No. 27 shall be a 1/2 inch pipe.
2. This right to tap is limited to the owner of the aforementioned Lot No. 27 and the said H. T. Peterson, his heirs and assigns, shall have no right to extend the line beyond the limits of Lot No. 27 or to allow anyone other than the owner of Lot No. 27 to tap on to said line. It is further understood and agreed that this right to tap is for the sole purpose of furnishing water to Lot No. 27 and is not to be extended to any other lot or any other property.
3. This right to tap involves no obligation on the part of J. F. Blackmon to furnish water to the owner of Lot No. 27 and involves no guaranties or warranties on the part of J. F. Blackmon as to any future use made of said water line, this being merely a license, granting to the said H. T. Peterson, his heirs and assigns, the right to tap on to said line as it now is.
