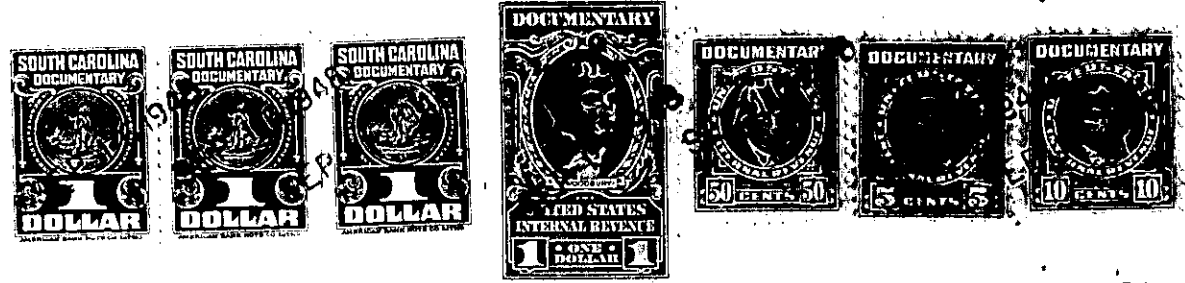

County, State of South Carolina on the east side of the extension of North Main Street of the Town of Fountain Inn, U. S. Highway No. 276, and having the following metes and bounds, according to a plat and survey made by E. E. Gary, Surveyor, on September 10, 1948, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of said Street or U. S. Highway No. 276, said iron pin measuring a distance of two hundred forty feet from the joint corner of the said J. B. Gault and lands of the Lillian Gault estate, now owned by L. R.
