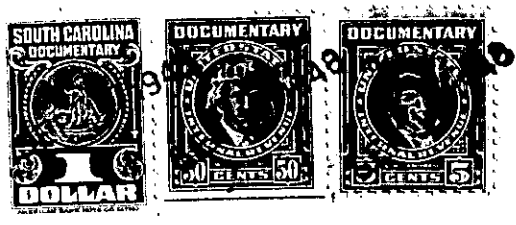

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township,  
County, State of South Carolina on the Jonesville Road in the Town of Simpsonville  
and being a portion of the A. J. Brashier homestead and more specifically  
described by courses and distances and metes and bounds as follows:  
Beginning on F. A. Hunter's line on the west side of the Jonesville Road  
and runs thence along his line N. 52-45 W. 142 feet to a branch; thence  
along branch in a southwesterly direction 118 feet to a corner on Brashier  
lands; thence S. 52-45 E. 142 feet to corner on the western side of Jones-  
ville Road; thence along that road N. 39-22 E. 118 feet to the beginning cor-  
ner.

Also all that piece, parcel or strip of land on the Jonesville Road,  
County and State aforesaid, in the Town of Simpsonville and lying between
