leased, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Rhoda Baker, her
heirs and assigns, forever: .

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State
of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot #10 of Block F, of Judson
Mills #2 Village and shown on Plat by Dalton & Neves, March 1939, and
recorded in Plat Book "K", Pages 1 and 2, R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County, S. C., and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pipe on the West side of 8th Avenue,
joint corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10, and running thence with 8th Avenue,
N. 29-10 E. 55 feet to an iron pipe; thence still with 8th Avenue, N.
1-21 W. 56.8 feet to an iron pipe, joint corner of Lots Nos 10 and 11;
thence with the line of Lot No. 11, S. 81-09 W. 133.6 feet to an iron
pipe in the rear line of Lot No. 5; thence with the rear line of Lot
No. 5, S. 8-43 E. 6 feet to an iron pipe, joint rear corner of Lots
Nos. 9 and 10; thence with the line of Lot No. 9, S. 53-22 E. 131.4
feet to the beginning corner.
