leased, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W.L. Witherspoon- -

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Cleveland - - - - - Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, being situated on the Old Springfield Road and con-
taining 48 acres, more or less. Said property being a portion of the
land of the S.C. Mills Estate and having the following metes and bounds,
to-wit:-

BEGINNING at a stone on the Blue Ridge, said point being in the
line of the States of North and South Carolina and running S. 39-30 E.
2,030 feet to a stake in the center of the Old Springfield Road; thence
along the old Springfield Road S. 54 W. 629 feet to a stake in the
center of the same road, said point being in the Moore line; thence with
the Moore line N. 20 W. 278 feet to a stake, said point being the N.E.
corner of Moore property; thence continuing along the Moore line S. 70
W. 355 feet to a stone in said line; thence N. 54-20 W. 1678 feet to
white oak tree on top of Blue Ridge, said point being in the North and
South Carolina State line; thence with said Blue Ridge and State line
