S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated December 9, 1945, the following courses and distances:

Beginning at a stake in the center of Old Spartanburg-Greenville Road at corner of property now or formerly belonging to Mrs. Elsie Hudson and running thence along line of property of Elsie Hudson and L. E. Hudson, N. 49-45 W. 864.3 feet to stone at corner of property of E. G. Green; thence along line of E. G. Green property N. 55-30 E. 620.5 feet to a point at corner of other property of Grantor; thence along line of other property of grantor S. 48-11 E. 400 feet to stake; thence continuing along line of other property of grantor S. 19-48 E. 621 feet to a stake in the center of a county road, which stake is south of the Old Spartanburg-Greenville Road at corner of property of Mrs. Vessie Garren and L. A. Cunningham; thence along line of property of Cunningham S. 87-0 W. 286 feet to stake on the north side of Old Spartanburg-Greenville Road; thence S. 20-15 E. 25.5 feet to stake in center of Old Spartanburg-Greenville Road; thence along the center of said road S. 71 W. 89.3 feet to the beginning corner.
