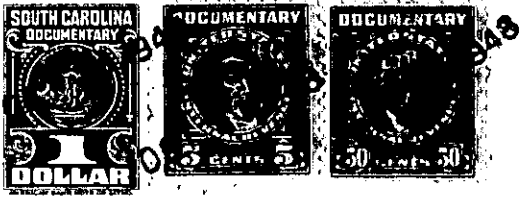

Deacons of Pleasant View Baptist Church, their successors in office forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, about five mile northwest from Greer, lying east# of the Rutherford Road, being a part of the same land that was conveyed to me by deed recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 283 at page 226, and being bounded on the north by lands of Leatherwood, on the east by lands of John Moon, on the west by other lands of myself and on the west by lot of Pleasant View Baptist Church, and having the following courses and distances, to wit :-

Beginning on a stonebehing the Pleasant View Baptist Church, joint corner of the present lot of the church and on the Leatherwood line, and runs thence with the Leatherwood line S. 87-45 E. 244 feet to a stone, John Moon's corner; thence with the Moon line and an old abandoned road S. 3-15 E. 238.5 feet to an iron pin in the said old road and on the Moon line, new corner; thence a new line N. 87-45 W. 315 feet to an iron pin on the present church lot line and on the northeast bank of the Rutherford Road; thence with the Church lot line N. 13-45 E. 243 feet to the beginning corner, and containing One and One Half (1.5) Acres, more or less.
