

County. State of South Carolina, situated about three miles Northwest from Greer on the Eastern side of the Rutherford Road, designated as Lots Nos. 32 and 33 on a Plat of property made for I.D. Bishop by H.S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated July, 1948, and having courses and distances as set forth below:

Lot No. 32: Beginning at a stake, corner of Lots Nos. 45,46 and 31, and running thence S. 66.45 W. 200 feet to a stake on new road, corner of Lot No. 31; thence along Eastern edge of said road, N. 23.15 W. 50 feet to a stake on said road, corner of Lot No. 33; thence N. 66.45 E. 200 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 33 and on line of Lot No. 45; thence S. 23.15 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
