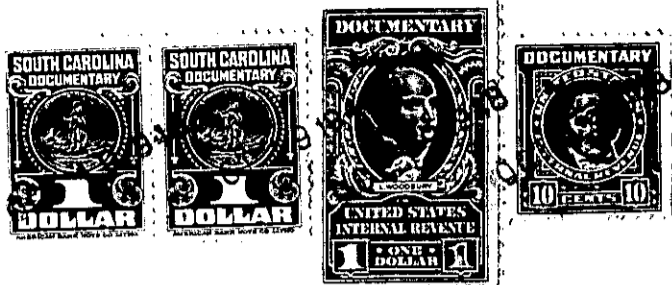

do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said JACK J. WOOTEN

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as lot number 20 of a subdivision known as Highview Acres, a Plat of which is of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "0", at Page 123, and having the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning at a point on the West side of Courtland Drive which point is 905.6 ft. North of the Northwest intersection of Courtland Drive and Sulphur Springs Road, the joint front corner of lots numbers 20 and 21, and running thence with the joint line of lots numbers 20 and 21 N. 84-30 W. 650.5 ft. to a point in the Eastern line of lot number 26; thence with the Eastern line of lot number 26 N. 6-47 W. 204.7 ft. to a point; thence with the joint line of lots numbers 19 and 20 S. 84-30 E. 694 ft. to a point on the West side of Courtland Drive; thence with the West side of Courtland Drive S. 5-30 W. 200 ft. to the point of beginning.
