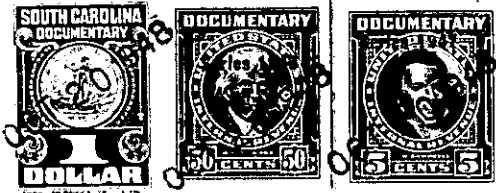

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **Claude Melvin Shaw, Jr**  
**his heirs and assigns for ever.**

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in **Greenville** Township, **Greenville**  
County, State of South Carolina, being about ~~two~~<sup>3</sup> miles west of the City of  
**Greenville, off-the White Horse Road. and fronting a new cut Street.**  
to wit **West Boulevard.**

**BEGINNING** at a point on **West Bulovard**, at iron pin at joint  
corner of tract of land now owned by said **Claude Melvin Shaw, Jr** Thence  
running **S 11-48 E. 100 feet** to iron pin at the rear joint corner of
